The Erber Family Foundation is proud to present our 2022 Annual Report prepared specifically for the 2022 Annual General Meeting. In this report, the Foundation will detail our current operations and the program's accomplishments in 2022.

The Erber Family Foundation was officially approved as a charitable organization by the government of Thailand on April 19th, 2021. The Foundation's purpose has always been to provide support to underprivileged children from impoverished backgrounds by giving them the opportunity for a high-quality education in a nurturing environment that they would not otherwise have the opportunity to experience. In addition to traditional education, our program also emphasizes life skills and morals that enable our students to mature into adults that are able to support themselves and their future families and make a positive impact within their communities.



The Foundation currently provides support to the original students that Professor Dr. Erich Erber first started the program with in 2019. We have also accepted additional new students into the program each year since our inception in 2019. Currently we have 18 students enrolled in the program and they all are studying at the Panyaden International School in Chiang Mai. The Foundation supports the students by taking full responsibility for each student's expenses (tuition, room and board, meals, activities, etc) as well as employing our Children teachers and housekeepers. The Children teachers are an invaluable part of the program's success and are with the children around the clock, 24/7. They instill a family atmosphere within the program and genuinely care about each student's development and well-being. The Foundation's Board of Directors maintain close contact with the teachers and also meet virtually and in person with the students. Each board member strives to get to know each student in the program individually.

In 2022, like the 2 years prior, the COVID-19 Pandemic had a huge impact on the children's living and learning. The Foundation worked closely with the teachers to facilitate an in person and virtual curriculum, that provided the best learning opportunities to the students in the safest manner possible. Online learning has been a common practice with the students doing lots of work on the computer this past year. Despite having been confined to the house more than they would like, the children are doing well and now with the COVID-19 situation improving, they will be able to experience more activities at school and during their free time this upcoming year.

Last but certainly not least as far as accomplishments go for 2022, we are proud to announce the Foundation's official website, [www.Erberfamilyfoundation.com](http://www.Erberfamilyfoundation.com). This website will give anyone that is interested in the Foundation's work an in depth look into our program and its current activities. It is also where one can go to make a contribution to help support our operations and overall mission.

## Our Supporters


In fiscal year 2022, the Foundation received various donations and supports from the following benefactors:

**3. Chairman and the Foundation committee** had donated sports equipment, guitars, shoes, and sweaters to encourage children in music and sports and prepare for winter




#### 4. SAN group supports the foundation website

- **Tin Tin's Moving On Ceremony** This year, our girl Tin Tin moved to secondary and is in year 7 now. All the other girls came to her ceremony, congratulating her, and taking pictures. Congrats, Tin Tin - it was a joyful and memorable moment!



- **Y6 Overnight trip to Chiangdao** – This Thursday and Friday, our y6 students will go for overnight trip at Chiangdao for 1 night. They will experience the 2.8 km trekking around 3 hours. They were so excited and got ready for the upcoming trip. There will be only 4 kids staying at homestay so we will easily prepare meals for them.

- **Baitoey and Being 's trip to Maetang, Chiang Mai** – one overnight trip to Maetang on December 1st for travelling to Earth home where they will complete tasks, team building games, cooking and complete a trek.

- **Jack was selected by Prime FDC** – Jack got a great opportunity to go to Phuket with Prime FDC to train and play at a high competitive level with Cruzeiro AS and BISP Academy in Phuket between 2-4 December 2022.



## Activities at Erber Home

- **We organize after-school activities** such as drawing, cooking, review, practice writing, reading, speaking Thai and English. Including taking time to take care of the house and clothes.

- **August Birthday Party and Welcome Party for Bitoy.** We celebrated our August birthdays for Sophia, who was born on August 7<sup>th</sup>, and for Jack, who was born on August 8<sup>th</sup>. Moreover, we took this opportunity to welcome Bitoy to the EFF homestay. She is our lovely new member, and she studies at year 4. WELCOME Bitoy!



- **Helping Kittens Find a New Home** The kids helped to take care of the cat and named her "Ka-Nom-Pang" - which means bread. This name was created because we fed her a piece of bread the first time we met. The kids have been taking care of her since last year. Then she got pregnant and gave birth to 5 kittens in January 2022. Moreover, the last month she just had another more 5 kittens again. The kids were so excited and this time we helped the kittens to find new homes.



## Activities during the semester break:

- **Learning trip** Between June 19-21, the foundation brought children to visit the unmanned aircraft factory to learn about the cyberspace, attend a Thai dessert workshop, and visit Bang Saen Beach according to the objectives of the founder and chairman of the foundation who want children have the opportunity to see new places to open up a world of learning that could inspire careers in the future for children. After the trip, we send them to the parents so the children has the opportunity to take care of their parents and spent time with the family during the semester break.



- **EFF band** It was initiated by Mr. Richard Erber who wanted to teach music and set up a band for children of the foundation. There is also a plans to organize concerts to raise money for the children, with friends of Mr. Richard helping to teach music during the school holidays, and there is Kru Maprang helps to support and take the children to watch the band contest. The winners of the contest were all female and were the same age as our children, This surprised and inspired them immensely



## Activities during the semester break:

### - English Lesson and Fun Activities with Chiara

Ms. Chiara, from Australia, had volunteered to teach English to children from December 18 until the end of the year. Fun activities such as cooking are held, where she taught the children how to cook homemade pasta. Some of the children also helped teaching Chiara Thai. She took the children to experience English outside home, such as markets, farms, zoos, shopping malls. It's been a great experience for everyone who's learned to share, connect and build strong relationships.
